
NOTICE OF UPCOMING WORK

Queen's Park Reconstruction Project

WHAT IS HAPPENING?

An Unmanned Aerial Vehicle – commonly known as a Drone – will be used to conduct a survey of the Macdonald Block Podium and the Hearst, Hepburn, Mowat and Ferguson Towers.

WHEN?

Saturday, January 21, 2017 between 7am and 6pm.

WHY?

The survey will assess the condition of the exterior stone walls of the Macdonald Block Complex.

HOW WILL THIS AFFECT ME?

This work is not expected to be noisy but will result in some pedestrian restrictions around the Macdonald Block Complex (900 Bay Street). There will also be intermittent, short-term lane traffic closures on Bay St. and Wellesley St. while the drone is in flight. Paid duty police officers will be on-site to direct traffic.

These pedestrian and traffic restrictions are necessary to comply with the clearances required by Transport Canada for unmanned aerial vehicles.
