College Station – Overnight Work Second Exit/Entrance & Easier Access Project

Timeline: Week of January 18, 2021

What we are doing and why?

As part of the Second Exit/Entrance and Easier Access construction at College Station, overnight work is required the week of January 18, 2021. The work involves the installation and relocation of underground cables on Yonge Street and at the Yonge and College/Carlton intersection. In order to complete the work safely and prevent the interruption of vehicular and streetcar movements on College Street, work is required to take place overnight when traffic is reduced.

What to expect

- During overnight hours on January 18, 19, 20, 21 and 23, a small work crew will be in the area to complete the installation and relocation of underground cables.
- Equipment will include work vehicles, a cable pulling machine, and generators on site to provide power.
- A generator at the trailer site located at 21 Granby Street will also be operating overnight to provide power to washrooms and break rooms/warming stations.
- Work hours will be from approximately 10pm to 6am the following morning.
- Noise will be kept to a minimum as best as possible.

Access:

- The majority of work will take place within the existing work zone on Yonge Street and at the intersection of Yonge and College street. A Paid-duty officer will be on site to help control traffic.
